Capacitor Voltage Hold up (During Input Power Interruption)

Suppose, I have a single 100nF input capacitor at my 12V. And. Suppose, the 12V drops to 0V for some, say 100us, and then comes back up to stable 12V. Will that 100nF capacitor be able to provide the stable 12V. No, the 12 volt dropping to zero volts will drag the capacitor voltage along for the ride and you get no benefit.

Basically you need to choose one which will switch in the super capacitor when power is lost from the power adaptor. In normal operation after the capacitor has been charged it will just sit there being topped up every so often until needed.
