Just two solar power plants are up and running in Cambodia at present, one a 10-MW plant developed by Singapore's Sunseap and another, 60-MW facility in Kampong Speu. However, considering the country's historical energy mix, the existing solar capacity appears positive. As of 2011, Cambodia had no solar power.
