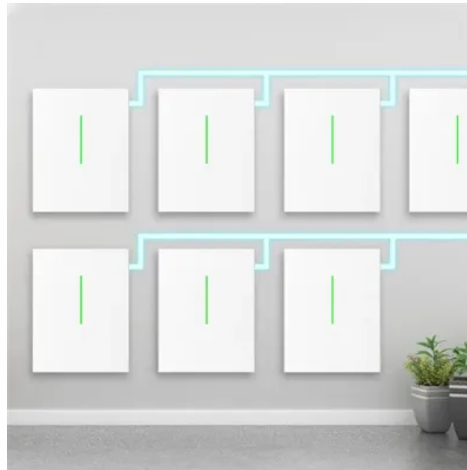


Solar power generation system for poor households
